

Q. Have you got a list of liquors that have been bought within the last 10 years? A. Yes a portion of the time

Q. Just read it to the Committee.

A. The last whiskey was bought in 1875 Dec. 28. Had then on hand 43 gallons, since used 37 gallons. Then Jan. 20 1880 we ~~was~~ had on hand cognac brandy, 5 gallons, since used 3 gallons up to this date. California brandy bought Jan. 20 1880, 6 gallons. The same amount on hand now, it has not been touched. At the same time, 6 gallons of port wine was purchased, and that remains untouched. At the same date 6 gallons of Anglica wine, since used 4 1/2 gallons. At the same date we purchased 5 gallons of Holland gin, since use 2 1/2 gallons. April 17 1880 we purchased 46 gallons of alcohol and have since used 11 gallons. That comprises all of the liquors purchased since 1875 with the exception of a barrel of whiskey which has not been tapped.

Dr. Cushing: How much whiskey have you used a week during the last year on an average? A. About a pint a week I believe; about 8 ounces of brandy and about the same
