

has subsisted a dispute between the said Proprietors respecting the bounds and extent of their several Tracts aforesaid which lie contiguous to each other - and Whereas both of said Proprietors have claimed the two following Tracts of Land as within their bounds One one Tract, bounded beginning four Miles distant northeast from a pitch pine stump standing on the Edge of the bank on the Western side of Bloufurn River so called in said County of York, and in the head line of the Town of Wells - thence running the same course North east towards Saco river two miles - thence north-west four miles - thence southwest two miles - thence south east four miles to the first bounds - the other tract bounded beginning at the north corner of the tract above described - thence running south west three miles and one Quarter adjoining fortwo miles on the first described tract - thence North West two miles - thence North East three miles and one Quarter - thence South East two miles to the first bounds -

Therefore for an amicable settlement of said dispute and fixing the bounds between the said Tracts of said proprietors respectively - they the said Proprietors by their said Agents and Attorneys have agreed and do hereby agree - that the North east and the North west side lines of the tract of land first above bounded and described are and shall be the true dividing lines and bounds, between the lands of said Proprietors respectively - and in order to carry said agreement into Effect, and for the consideration hereafter mentioned the said Propriety first abovenamed by the said Joseph Waters their Agent and attorney authorized as aforesaid do hereby grant release and confirm to the propriety last above named their Heirs and assigns forever in their
