M: Waters the Agent of the Proprietors made a  
Report of his proceedings and it was thereupon  
moved - Whether the Agent be empowered in the  
Name of this Propriety to apply to some able Lawyer  
for his Opinion; whether certain settlers upon Lands  
belonging to the propriety who have been prosecuted  
at the Court of Common Pleas held in the County of  
York in October last by Samuel Small & others  
in an Action of Ejectment, in which the settlers  
obtained a Judgment, and the Plaintiffs appealed  
to the supreme judicial Court whether they can  
avail themselves in the Supreme Court by quit  
claims made to them by this Propriety of the  
Lands in question after the commencement of  
the Action as aforesaid - And in case it shall  
be the Opinion of the said Council that  
they cannot avail themselves as aforesaid  
then; whether it be the Intent of this Propriety  
that the Agent be and hereby is empowered to  
commence and carry on to final Issue an Action  
against the said Small and others or any person  
holding under them - passed in the Affirmative
