Ordered That a committee of one from each County on the part of the House with such as the Senate may join be a committee to inquire into the expediency of establishing a Library for the use of the Legislature and Messrs Hobbs of Eastport, Ide of Frankfort, Shaw of Orono, Bradbury of Athens, McMillan of Fryeburg, Chadwick of Gardiner, Dunken of Cranberry Isle and Phelps of Phippsburg, Woodbury of mind & Holmes of Alfred were appointed on the part of the House.

Ordered, That the joint standing Committee on the Judiciary be instructed to inquire into the expediency of repealing an Act of March 17 1831 entitled an act concerning corporations, or if so restricting the same that it shall not extend to companies incorporated for the construction of Rail Roads and canals.
