 Legislature of the State, and also from the Legisla-
 ture of the State, and also from the Legislature of
 Massachusetts before the separation, designating
 the amount in money and the amount in land,
 the date of each donation, the date of the incorpora-
 tion of each College &c, and the State of the funds
 of each, by the last returns - & the House concurred.

Copy of Report of Sewall Prescott, Agent for the

 read & referred in concurrence with the Senate to the
 Committee on State Roads.
