

The order of yesterday in relation to criminal prosecutions - fines & forfeitures &c, came from the Senate nonconcurring & referred to the Committee on the Judiciary - and the House acceded & concurred.

Report on petition of Solomon Littlefield, referred in this House yesterday to a joint select committee came from the Senate nonconcurring & committed to the Committee on Claims - and the House insisted upon their vote of yesterday.

On motion by Mr Cunningham of Swanville -
 Ordered That the Committee on the Judiciary be instructed to inquire into the expediency of requiring by Law presiding Officers in our Cities, Towns, & Plantations meetings holden on the 2^d Monday of Sept. annually to read to the Electors on opening of said meeting the 3^d sect. of an Act entitled an additional act regulating Elections passed March

1831.

The Committee on engrossed Bills reported as duly engrossed Bill - An Act to incorporate the Waldo Fire & Marine Insurance Company which was passed to be Enacted. Sent up for concurrence

Petitions of the Inh. of Bucksport
 - Inh. of Milford - in relation to the fisheries on the Penobscot River - were severally read & referred to the Committee on Interior Fisheries - Sent up for concurrence.

Petition of Robert M. N. Smith & others for a Bank at Stillwater with a capital of \$500,000 - was read & referred to the Committee on Banks and Banking. Sent up for concurrence.
