brother to:

Joe Lola, { Pste Lola, a big strong man, had been with a circus,  
6 ft tall weighed 190 died about 1867, father's friend -  
Tom Lola, lieutenant in army, came to us as a  
recruiting officer, lived in Vermont

John Nelson (half breed) & John Barber (do) went to war  
and one of the other Lolas. Cavalry, infantry and  
artillery were all represented by volunteers.
