

Monday February 22nd 1836

Met according to adjournment.

Report of the Committee on the subject of Capital punishments, came from the Senate that body ordering 1000 copies to be printed for the use of the Legislature & the House concurred.

Bill—An Act to incorporate the Bethel Bridge Company, was read 1st & 2^d time & tomorrow at ten o'clock assigned for a 3^d reading.

Bill—An Act to incorporate the Penobscot Steam Navigation Company, was read a 1st & 2^d time & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3^d reading.
