On motion by Mr. Little of Portland,

Ordered, That the Committee on Canals & Rail roads be instructed to inquire into the expediency of a general act in relation to petitions for acts of Incorporation for Canal & Rail road Companies; also into the expediency of a general act defining the rights and duties of Canals and Rail road Corporations. Sent up for concurrence.

Ordered, That the Committee on State Lands be instructed to inquire whether any errors or frauds have occurred in the selection or assignment of the lands under a resolve of the last Legislature for the benefit of the Officers and soldiers of the Revolutionary War and the Widows of such deceased officers & soldiers. Sent up for concurrence.
