same. Voted that the Clerk be desired to write Mr Sewal to desire him to
call Spawhawk to take such steps relating thereto as they shall think fit
to secure the prop^s title. Also that if they think it for the best to take
immediate possession of the Land belonging to the proprietors not yet laid
either by laying them out into Townships or otherwise as they may see
for the best to prevent any other persons taking possession of the same.

Voted that Col. Spawhawk and David Sewal Esq^r be & they be
impowered to make an exchange with Thomas Parsons of four of the
proprietors Lots in his Township for four of the best Lots of equal
in order to accommodate him in the Settlement.

Voted that the Clerk be desired to inform all the prop^s previous to
next meeting of the time thereof and that it is their design then
for their Lots in Mr Parsons' Township &c and that it be done by written
order.

Then the meeting was adjourned to the 18th of March next to meet at the
same place at four^o Clock P.M.
