

Thursday February 4th 1836.

Met according to adjournment.

Report of Lieut Col. Long was referred in concurrence with the Senate to the Committee on Rail Roads & Canals.

An order came from the Senate instructing the Committee on Literature &c to inquire into the expediency of fixing by law some mode of securing faithful & prompt returns by the Selectmen of the several towns, Aldermen of Cities, & Assessors of Plantations of the number of Scholars &c. as now required by an Act of the 11th of March 1834 and also to fix the compensation of superintending School Committees, & the House concurred.

Returns of Agricultural Societies was referred in concurrence with the Senate to the Committee on Agriculture.

Bill An Act to set off Nathaniel Carril from the town of Warren and annex him to the town of Camden, was read a third time & passed to be engrossed. Sent up for concurrence.

Petition of Nathaniel Stevens & others for authority to erect a dam across Little River Harbour — was read & referred in concurrence with the Senate to the Committee on Interior Waters.

Petition of the Trustees of Foxcroft Academy for a
