

The Report of the Committee on Roads and Bridges, granting leave to withdraw one petition of Gadock Humphrey and others came up re-committed read and concurred.

The Committee on Interior Waters reported leave to withdraw on petition of Charles T. Halley, and order of notice to next Legislature on petition of Ira Wadleigh and others — read and accepted, in concurrence.

Bill additional to an Act to incorporate the Moosehead Lake Steam Navigation Company (reported by the Committee on Interior Waters, on petition of the Moosehead Lake Steam Navigation Company) came up referred to the Committee to which was referred the "Bill to incorporate the Worcester and Kennebec Summer Company". The Senate nonconcur the House in said reference. Mr. Littlefield moved the indefinite postponement of the Bill; and the question was decided unanimously in affirmative, as follows, to wit:
