 walk out. Yesterday 40 or 50 perhaps
 walked out. For the six months
 prior to last week they got some
 exercise in the wards walking about.
 Some of them got other exercise, no
 great. About the same number did
 chores in the summer time. Then a
 large number worked on the farm,
 some times we had as many as
 50 on the farm; should think
 there might be 40 out ^{at work} every day.
