Bill An Act enlarging the powers of Constables in
 the Town of East Machias, was read a 1st & 2^d time
 and tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3^r reading.

Bill An Act giving power to the County Commissioners of York County to lay out a Road over
 Saco River, was read a 3^d time & passed to be engrossed
 in concurrence with the Senate.

Bill An Act additional to an Act to incorporate
 the Brunswick Company passed Feb'y 6th 1834
 was read a third time & passed to be engrossed in
 concurrence.

Bill An Act relative to the collection of State
 taxes & assessments made by County Commissioners
 was called up by Mr Steward of Anson and
 on motion referred to the committee on Finance.
