

422. Bill in addition to an Act establishing a Supreme Judicial Court, (reported by the Committee on the Judiciary on so much of the Governor's message as relates to the Judiciary) was read twice and its passage refused, in concurrence.

Bill to incorporate the Brunswick Savings Institution (reported by Mr. Magoun from the Committee on Banks and Banking and recommended the passage of said Bill without the amendments adopted by the Senate.) Mr. Strickland moved that said Bill be indefinitely postponed; and the question of indefinite postponement, being ordered to be taken by yeas and nays, was decided in the affirmative, as follows to wit:
