Q. Does that cover substantially all on the heating? A. That covers the principal amount of change except the fact that there have been new buildings added and they have been piped and attachments made. There has been a change in lighting the building since I have been here. I think there were changes before. There is an important change in this: that we were purchasing gas of the city, and that was changed, and we have been making an illuminating gas for some time over a year, and by reason of it we are getting it at cost, and we are using it very much more freely, so that the institution is now better lighted at a somewhat less cost. To obtain the same amount of light it costs us a little over 50 per cent of what it cost us before. There only 2 changes made in the sewerage system, one sanitary and the other economic
