

The order relative to petitions for incorporation 293.  
-ations, for the purpose of lumbering, erect-  
-ing Mills, sluices and other works, and the  
-order relative to petitioners for Acts of incorpo-  
-ration for the purpose of quarrying gran-  
-ite and other Stone, came up from the  
House severally referred to the Committee  
on Manufactures, with instructions to re-  
-port a Bill to take effect after the adjourn-  
-ment of the present Legislature, and the  
same, on motion of Mr. Maguire, were laid  
upon the table.

Bill to incorporate the Machias Port  
Mutual Fire Insurance Company was  
read the second time and passed to be engros-  
-sed. Sent down for concurrence. Concurred.

Bill providing for the distribution and  
repayment of the public money, appor-  
-tioned to the State of Maine, on deposit,  
by the government of the United States,  
was taken up. The Senate recede from their  
vote passing said Bill to be engrosed with  
the amendment **B**, adopt the amend-  
-ment **H** and **M** proposed by the House  
and pass said Bill to be engrosed, as further  
amended, in concurrence.
