Company

An Act to incorporate the Noridgewock Falls Company

An Act to incorporate the Calais Academy

An Act to incorporate the Damariscotta Duck Manu-  
facturing Company

An Act to prohibit constables from acting as attor-  
nies to parties in suits at Law

An Act to incorporate the town of Amity  
which were severally passed to be enacted. Sent up  
for concurrence

The same committee reported as truly engrossed

Bill An Act in relation to indictments against  
towns for neglect to repair their Highways

An Act to enable the Proprietors of the Megunticook  
Meeting House to sell the same

An Act to repeal An Act entitled An act re-  
quiring a sluiceway to be constructed on  
the Meduxnekeag Stream & for other purposes  
which were severally passed to be enacted. Sent up for  
concurrence.

Bill An Act to establish the Frankfort, Bangor &  
Belfast Railroad Corporation, came from the Senate  
rather amended, and the House accepted the same  
and passed the Bill to be engrossed in concurrence.

Resolve on Col. Stephen H. Longs Report on the  
routes from the Seaboard of Maine to the Canadian  
Frontier, was read a second time & passed to be en-
