Geo. H. Hunt says (1917) that he "never heard of it  
nor say any one nor a Caupunawehya."

Clara Repentin declares that they go every year still.  
that Wewel Francis ~~visit~~ last year, Old Saul Repentin,  
Joe Hecha, Gorr Aatten, Gorr. Soccabum Sraain, all met to  
the "K'itdi Scottaynah" a big council. (This is more  
than doubtful) "If he trouble me P'awtsch Lyons,  
then he help him."

Lewy says that when he was young near, but of voting  
age, Ateen Ateen tried to get 5% of him & others;  
said this would do to him finally it appeared that it  
had been voted for each one to pay 5% to defray expenses  
of delegates to Caupunawehya. Lewy said he would pay  
his to get rid of the old man, but he laughed at the  
being any necessity for it. Said it started the looking  
up of the custom. Says he believes he knows of  
Sebattis Mitchell going to Caupunawehya in the 70's

If Lewy was of voting age then this must have  
been in 1855 - for he was ten years younger than father  
voting age with Indians was 18 years - Lewy born 1834  
in 1852 a lot
