Resolve authorizing the constructing of a Stone flagging on the State lot north of the State House — was read once & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3^d reading.

Bill — An Act to incorporate the Maine Scythe and Shovel Manufacturing Company — was read 1st & 2^d time & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3^d reading.

Resolve — additional to a Resolve in favor of certain officers & soldiers of the Revolutionary war & the widows of the deceased officers & soldiers approved March 17 1835, was read twice & passed to be engrossed.

Resolve to pay the expenses of certain Indians of the Penobscot tribe, was read a second time & passed to be engrossed. Sent up for concurrence.
