

Wednesday January 13rd 1836.

Met according to adjournment.

A communication was received from Asaph Nichols signifying his acceptance as Secretary of State.

Petition of the Selectmen of Kennebunkport for an amendment of the Constitution, was read referred to Messrs Perkins of Kennebunkport, Chase of Camden, Chadbourne of Standish, Stanley of Dixfield, Eastman of Strong, McDowell of Washington, Davis of Newennon Whitmore of Kirkland, Bridges of Charlotte & Lake of Bucksport with such as the Senate may join.

Bill for an Act additional proceeding for the punishment of certain crimes & for the publication thereof which from the Senate files of last year came down referred to Messrs Penruddick, Robinson, Allen, Kellogg and Brickland with such as the House may join - and the House concurred & Messrs Alderman of Wells, Stony of Waterford, Cunningham of Swanville, Webb of Bloomfield, White of Windham, Allen of Bangor Holt of Pownall, Penruddick of Bowdoinham, Packard of Houlton & Faber of Vassalboro were joined.
