Resolve relating to Banking corporations (reported in the House by the Committee on Banks and Banking) was read once and recommended.

Sent down for concurrence.

Bill to incorporate the Worcester and Hennessee Lumber Company (reported in the House by the Committee on Manufactures on petition of Jesse W. Goodrich) came up from the House of Representatives, referred to a Joint Select Committee, consisting of Messrs. Ingalls of Denmark, Perkins of Biddeford, Woodman of New Gloucester, Palmer of Whitefield, Pellingill of Hancock, Vance of Beadfield, Sylvester of Phillips, Ames of Haddam, Allen of Bangor, and Comstock of Lubec, with such as the Senate may join, read and referred and Messrs. Littlefield, Mildnam, Robinson of Hennessee, Burk and Swift are joined in concurrence.

The report of the Committee on Roads and Bridges granting leave to withdraw on petition of Inhabitants of Bluehill came up the House, insisting on its vote referring said report to the Delegation from the County of Hancock, propose a conference, and appoint as conferees Messrs. Kinkley of Bluehill, Dunlap of Brunswick and Shaw of Orono and the same on motion of Mr. Littlefield was laid upon the table.
