Purposes mentioned in said Petition. Given under my
Hand & Seal this twelfth day of April Anno Domini
1769 and in the Ninth year of his Majesty's Reign

warned, to meet at the time & place and for the purpose
set forth in the foregoing Petition. Boston Apr 17. 1769

At a meeting of the Proprietors of the Land mentioned in
the foregoing Petition, in pursuance of the above said Notifi-
cation at the Common Hall in Boston, Wednesday June 7
1769

Voted that the Hon Nath^l Sparhawk Esq^r be the
Moderator of this meeting

Voted that Samuel Adams be the Proprietors Clerk
who was accordingly sworn by Nath^l Sparhawk Esq^r a
Justice of the Peace thro' out the Province

Then the meeting was adjourned to Wednesday the 14 Instant at
Six o'Clock P.M.
