Met according to adjournment.

Report on the <sup>order</sup> of the 19<sup>th</sup> January, as to quantity of land necessary to furnish the Revolutionary Officers & Soldiers &c, was read & accepted in concurrence.

Resolve in favor of John W Adams, was read once & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a second reading.

Resolve in favor of Henry L Noyes, was read once & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a second reading.

Resolve in favor of Samuel Baker, was read once and tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a second reading.

Bill An Act to annex a tract of land to Waldo Plantation, was read 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>d</sup> time & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3<sup>d</sup> reading.

Bill An Act concerning Hallowell Academy, was read a 3<sup>d</sup> time & passed to be engrossed as amended by striking out the Preamble. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill An Act to incorporate the Proprietors of the Goose River Mill Company, was amended in concurrence with the Senate as on sheet annexed marked A and passed to be engrossed in concurrence.

Bill An Act to incorporate the Costline Steam Mill Company, was amended in concurrence with the Senate, as on sheet annexed marked A, and passed to be engrossed in concurrence.
