Q. What is your view as to the merits of the lodge system as compared with the ^{bed} strap and straight-jacket system discarded there? A. From my standpoint I am inclined to think that the mechanical restraint would be more irksome to the patient.

By Dr. Oaks:

Q. I want to know if it is a general rule to put patients into the lodge without any clothing on? A. That I can give you no information upon. It is a thing I have very little to do with. I could not state about what proportion go in without any clothing on.
